RESPOND TO THE CENSUS FROM THE COMFORT OF YOUR HOME

For the first time, the Census will be available for individuals and families to respond online and by phone. While there will be various ways to respond, completing your Census questionnaire online will be the easiest, fastest and safest way to complete the 2020 Census. Anyone can visit www.my2020census.gov to complete the 2020 Census. Your response online can be done on a computer, tablet or smart phone.

During March, some homes will receive a paper questionnaire (sometimes known as the census form) in the mail. You are able to complete the paper questionnaire of the Census from your home and mail in your responses.

If you prefer, you can also complete the Census by phone in English or a dozen other languages.

WHY YOUR RESPONSE MATTERS

YOU ARE THE VOICE OF YOUR COMMUNITY.

When you fill out the Census and represent your community, your community gets a voice at the Federal level. Your Census response helps enhance schools, community centers, roads, hospitals and businesses, etc. It determines how federal funding is distributed; and how congressional seats are assigned.

THE CENSUS IS SAFE, SECURE AND CONFIDENTIAL.

Your answers can **never** be used by law enforcement, ICE or any other agency or court.

YOUR COMMUNITY COUNTS ON YOU. GET COUNTED!

The Census counts every person living in the U.S. regardless of age, religion, status, creed, etc. Completing the Census is mandatory, taking part is your civic duty: it's a way to participate in our democracy and say, "I COUNT!"
